

Vehicular travel for mission-critical research with more than one person per vehicle

Texas A&M AgriLife Research strongly encourages limiting travelers to one person per vehicle when traveling for approved, mission-critical research. If, however, you choose to travel with more than one person per vehicle, please read and sign below.

- According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, travel increases your chance of getting and spreading COVID-19.
- Traveling with more than one person per vehicle could increase exposure to or transmission of COVID-19 if one of the vehicle's occupants has the virus.
- Each vehicle occupant agrees to follow these rules while traveling:
 - Take temperature prior to travel and if you have a fever, then do not travel.
 - Wear a mask covering nose and mouth when in the vehicle and while in public places when stopping en route to the destination.
 - The ventilation system must be turned on but not placed into recirculation mode at any time.
 - When possible, crack windows to allow more fresh airflow.
 - Follow CDC guidelines on washing hands and frequent sanitizing of contact surfaces (use sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol).
 - No more than 50% occupancy of the vehicle while maintaining at least 6 feet between passengers.
 - Plan ahead to minimize stops and review CDC guidance for travelers prior to travel.
