Additional Volunteer Fire Department Grants VFDs are the state's first line of defense against wildfires. The current amount of unfunded VFD grant requests is \$170 million.



Wildfire and Emergency Response Bills

The agency has maintained minimal reliance on costly out-of-state resources. However, large and destructive wildfires require additional resources including aircraft and associated personnel that are not funded within normal agency appropriations.
